We Would Love For You To Be A Sponsor of Scout-O-Rama 2018

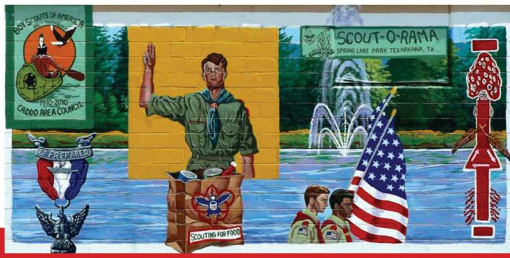
